Adaptive Actions do not adapt to a situation but adapts a situation. It suggests iterations and transversal operations, new forms of connexions and relationalities. AA invites creative resistance by the activation of different forms of adaptation. In the form of a round-table we will look at a number of submitted actions (both online and at the camp) and question their adaptive power, the way they succeed at adapting a situation, at resisting creatively. Guests will discuss some of their own actions in order to highlight the main constraints they faced and the ways in which these constraints have been reconfigured, becoming motors of creation, points of captivation, that is micropolitical activations.
